acknowledged, has bargained and sold and by these presents does bargain, sell and convey to said part ies of the second part and
their heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land in Winston Township, Forsyth County, North Carolina,
bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron stake located at the Northwest corner of the intersection
of Cleveland Avenue and 24th Street; running thence with the North line of 24th Street
North 88 degrees West 100 feet to a cross on wall, Southeast corner of Lot No. 23 on
the hereinafter mentioned map; running thence with the East line of Lot No. 23 North
2 degrees East 110 feet to an iron stake; thence South 88 degrees East 100 feet to
an iron stake in the West line of Cleveland Avenue; thence with said line South 2
