WHEREAS, on the 27th day of August, 1985, Bertram V. Dupree and wife, Patricia L. Dupree, executed and delivered unto J. L. Holmes, et ux; thence with Holmes' east line, and on a line parallel to the west line of White Street, southwardly 140 feet to an iron stake in the north line of an alley; thence with the north line of the alley eastwardly 50 feet, more or less, to an iron stake, the southwest corner of the property of M.
