WHEREAS, notice of said meeting was published once a week for four successive weeks in the Winston-Salem Journal, a newspaper published in the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, pursuant to order of the Board of Aldermen in the resolution fixing the date for hearing on the above-described petition and notice of the closing and public hearing was posted in at least two prominent places along said portion ADOPTED BOARD OF ALDERMEN of alley proposed to be closed; and

Thence with the right-of-way N 12° 26′ 15" East 30.00' to the Point and Place of BEGINNING, containing 0.29 acre, more or less.
