KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the undersigned, Betty C. Williams, having qualified as Executor of the Estate of Pearl Alsbrooks Washington (Davis), deceased, late of Forsyth County, North Carolina (hereinafter, "Grantor") (see Forsyth County Estate File 00 E 1117) and the Last Will and Testament of the deceased made numerous devises of real estate:

NOW THEREFORE, Betty C. Williams, Executor of the Estate of Pearl Alsbrooks Washington (Davis) in order to fulfill the devises under the Last Will and Testament of Pearl Alsbrooks Washington (Davis) and to create chain of title does hereby grant, convey, and release unto James Leon Washington (hereinafter "Grantees") in fee simple absolute, all that certain property situate in County of Forsyth and State of North Carolina, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron stake on the East side of Glenn Avenue 200 feet South of the Southeast intersection of Glenn Avenue and 28th Street; thence East parallel with 28th Street 150 feet to an iron stake, in the West line of a 15 foot alley; thence south along the West side of said fifteen foot alley 50 feet to an iron stake; thence West parallel with 28th Street 150 feet to an iron stake in the East line of Glenn Avenue; thence North along the East line of Glenn Avenue 50 feet to an iron stake, the place of beginning, being Lot No. 5, as shown on the map entitled Bon Air Realty Company, made by C. E. Ellerbe, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Forsyth County, in Plat book 3, page 25; also being a part of that certain tract of parcel of land conveyed to P. H. It was determined that Joe Lewis Alsbrooks was not a child of Pearl Alsbrooks Washington (Davis). Therefore, this property passes to James Leon Washington.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid property unto the aforesaid grantees, and their successors and assigns forever, in fee simple absolute, in perpetuity, together with all rights, members, hereditament, and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in anyway incident or appertaining.
