AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS A LOCAL HISTORIC LANDMARK

WHEREAS, all of the prerequisites to the adoption of this ordinance as prescribed by Chapter 160D, Article 9, Part 4 of the North Carolina General Statutes have been met; and

WHEREAS, Salem Bottling, LLC has submitted a local historic landmark designation application and report, consenting to the designation of the property as a local historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Forsyth County Historic Resources Commission has submitted a designation application and report, which is incorporated herein by reference, and does recommend after a public hearing that the property described below be designated a local historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem, after a separate public hearing, finds that the property described herein is of architectural significance and historic integrity; the property's preservation should be encouraged; and the qualifying elements exist as set forth in the designation application/report.


