ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF L & L OF GASTONIA, INC.

- I, the undersigned, a natural person of the age eighteen (18) years or more, do make and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a business corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Worth Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT," and to that end, do hereby set forth.
 - The name of the Corporation is. T. & T. of Castonia, Inc.
- The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
- The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:
 - (a) To own, operate, manage and/or lease any and all types of restaurants and eating establishments including but not limited to operations known as "fast food service systems" designed for the sale of any and all types of food and/or drink.
 - (b) To engage in any lawful act or activity for which Corporations may be organized under Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of Morth Carolina.
- 4.
