ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THIS CERTIFIES that the undersigned does hereby organize a

Corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina,

(G.S. 55) and to that end does hereby set forth:

I.

The name of the Corporation is C AND D ENTERPRISES, INC.

II.

The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- (a) To manufacture, buy, sell, import and export, and to lease, rent and operate game machines of all types. To procure by purchase or otherwise all necessary patents, licenses and permits authorizing the manufacture and sale of said game machines.
