

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF D & L BRENDLE CORP.

- I, the undersigned, a natural person of the age eighteen (18)31043 years or more, do make and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporational tion for the purpose of forming a business corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT," and to that end, do hereby set forth.
